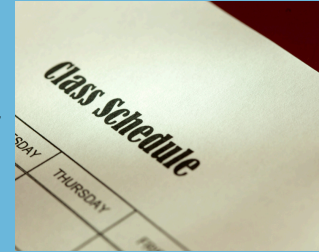

KINDER

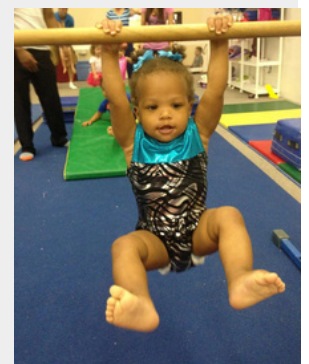
As our new session begins, we're excited to welcome all our new members to the Seahorse program! We currently offer two class options: a skill-based program and a play-based program, allowing us to tailor the experience to best suit your child's needs and interests.

We wanted to give you an overview of what to expect in the first few months. Your child will be eager to explore the gym and all the equipment, and during the initial weeks, you may find yourself chasing after them to bring them back to the group. This is completely normal! It's all part of the process as they learn about structure and following instructions in a fun and supportive environment.

We promise that, over time, your child will become more comfortable and stay with the group at their designated station, working on the skills we focus on during each session. Our goal is to help them understand what to do at each station, with your support, and to do so safely!

Once they've mastered this ability, they'll progress into a Kinder program that teaches the basic fundamentals of gymnastics. After completing the parented classes, they'll move on to our Mini Gymnastics class (unparented) and begin the CANGym program at Level 1.
